Students join SOAR Scholars in the 10th grade and work with an early commitment advisor during 10th, 11th and 12th grades*.



Students in grades 10 and 11, who meet the pledge requirements, will receive \$500 in an Invest529[™] account. Students in grade 12, who meet the pledge requirements, will receive \$1,000 in an Invest529 account.



SOAR scholarship funds can be applied toward qualified post-secondary education expenses and/or expenses required for participation in a registered apprenticeship program.

* Highland High School and Bath County High School students may begin in the 9th grade Award amounts for 9th and 10th grades are \$250 for students beginning in 9th grade. To enroll in SOAR Scholars, students must meet eligibility requirements including:

Have a valid Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number

Be a Virginia resident and a student in grades 10–12, enrolled in a participating SOAR Scholars high school

Agree to comply with the SOAR Scholars pledge, including the minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher at the time of enrollment
